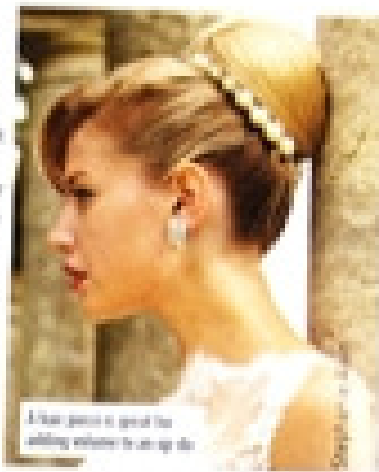

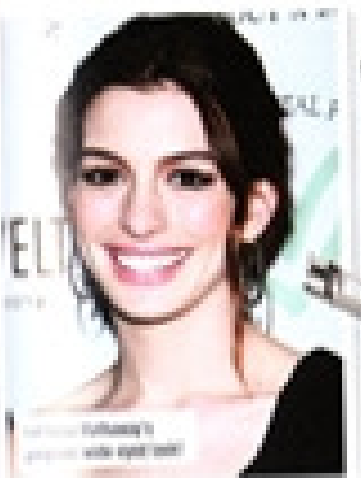
A Mel says: Clinique are actually about to launch a product that is perfect for your problem — the Even Better Clinical Dark Spot Corrector (£27.50). It's a serum that can reduce age spots and blotches in just four weeks, and the longer you use it for, the more effective it becomes. It'll be available in Sainsbury's from 19th March, and nationwide from 1st May.

Q I've always had a really lovely bob for my big day, but I've never got too long hair. Are there any ideas of creating the most remarkable 'do? If so, will I have to have my hair done before it is too long about wedding time? *Frances, via email*

A Errol says: Extensions are a very expensive option — steer clear of them unless you are desperate for long hair. The quick fix is to use hair pieces that attach to your hair but still look natural. Go for non-synthetic hair as it looks much better when you style it. For a ballgown bob, put your hair in a low chignon and then attach the hair piece around it. You'll only need a piece that is 16 to 18 inches long. Your hairdresser should have them in stock, but I'd let them know just in case!

Bright eyes

Q I have quite small eyes — are there any make-up tricks I can use to widen them for my big day? *Charlie, London*

A David says: To make your eyes look larger, apply a beige or white pencil to the inside of the lower eye line. Wear a pale shadow on the eyelid to reflect and open up the eye, and extend your dark eyeliner a few extra millimetres beyond the edge of the upper and lower lash lines.
